(HARROGATE, KNARESBOROUGH, PANNAL AND BURN BRIDGE) (PARKING AND WAITING)
(AMENDMENT NO 53) ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend "North Yorkshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Harrogate) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

1	Orchard Close (U1017/3/70), Knaresborough	Both	<p>On the north eastern side of Orchard Close spur, the double yellow road markings start from the spur of Orchard Close in a south easterly direction for 3m rotating to a north easterly direction for 21m.</p> <p>On the eastern side of Orchard Close starting directly opposite the termination point on the western side for a length of 29m in a south westerly direction, terminating at the tangent of the junction.</p>
