

## **STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

The County Council as the traffic authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the traffic regulation order:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (b) for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (d) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; or
- (e) for any of the purposes specified in paragraphs (a) to (c) of subsection (1) of Section 87 of the Environment Act 1995 (air quality).

Proposed location: At the junction of Silver Street and Arkengarthdale Road, extending 14m to the East on Silver Street and 23m to the North on Arkengarthdale Road.

Proposed introduction of a 'No Waiting At Any Time' double yellow line waiting restriction
