Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

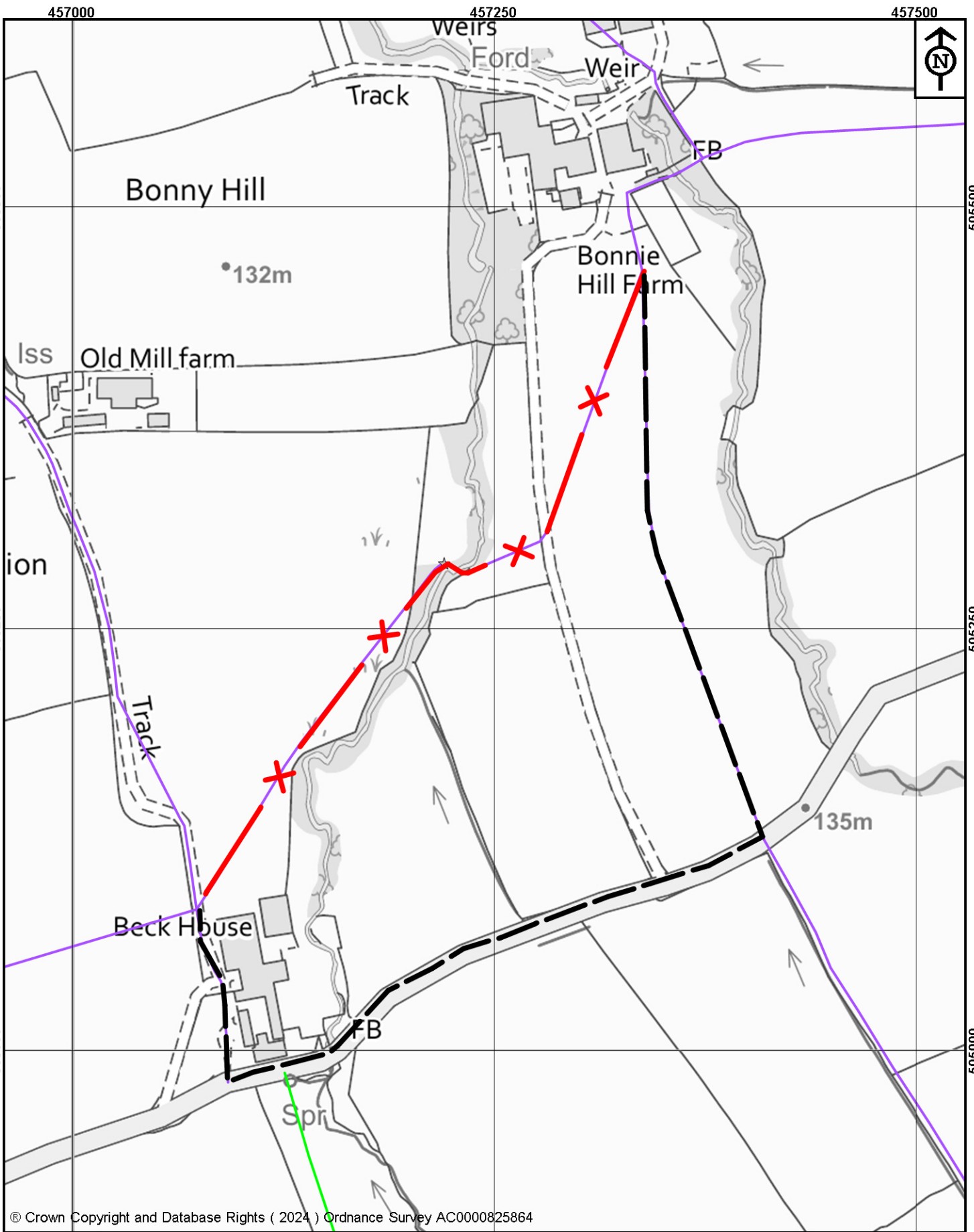
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 10.75/12/2 in the Parish of Ingleby Greenhow, between grid reference NZ57330546 and NZ57070508 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 17th May 2024 and 25th October 2024 due to a dangerous footbridge. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 156.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
