

## **Adoption Statement**

### **Notification under Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)**

#### **Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended)**

In accordance with the above regulations, notice is hereby given that the Minerals & Waste Joint Plan 2015–2030 and accompanying Policies Map was formally adopted by North Yorkshire County Council on 16 February 2022. This replaces in full the North Yorkshire Minerals Local Plan and the North Yorkshire Waste Local Plan.

The Minerals & Waste Joint Plan 2015 – 2030 was the subject of an independent examination conducted by Elizabeth Ord, Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The examination included public hearing sessions between January 2018 and February 2019. The Inspectors' Report was issued on 16 February 2022 and concluded that the Joint Plan is sound and legally compliant, subject to the Inspectors' main modifications pursuant to Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

The adopted Minerals & Waste Joint Plan 2015–2030 (February 2022) incorporates all the main modifications set out in the appendix to the Inspectors' Report, as well as the Authority's additional minor modifications to the Submission Plan. Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Minerals and Waste Joint Plan 2015-2030 may make an application to the High Court, under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power of the local planning authority and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made not later than 30 March 2022 (six weeks from the date of adoption).
