INCLUDE WHITBY TOWN CENTRE**

THE SCARBOROUGH PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2017

Scarborough Borough Council has made the following extension and variation to the Order under section 60, 61 and 72 in relation to the consumption of alcohol and psychoactive substances, urination and defecation. The original order came into force on the 1st July 2017 and the extension and variation (to include the Whitby Town Centre) comes into force on the 4th June 2020.

Extension and Variation of Original Order

1. The Original Order is extended with immediate effect, for a period of 3 years from the date of this order (4th June 2020).
2. The Original Order at paragraph 1.2 (c) is varied and the amended schedule of plans (see below) applies. The entire order now relates to the area outlined in red on the following plans:
 - a) Whitby Town Centre
 - b) Scarborough
3. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds the extension is necessary to prevent:
 - a) occurrence or recurrence after that time of the activities identified in the order, or
 - b) an increase in the frequency or seriousness of those activities after that time.
4. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that:
 - a) activities carried on in a public place in the Whitby Town Centre area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality; and
 - b) the effect, or the likely effect, of the activities is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature; is, or is likely to be, such as to make the activities unreasonable; and justifies the restrictions imposed by the notice.

If any interested person desires to question the validity of this variation on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that a requirement of the act has not been complied with in relation to the variation, he or she may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date of the variation.

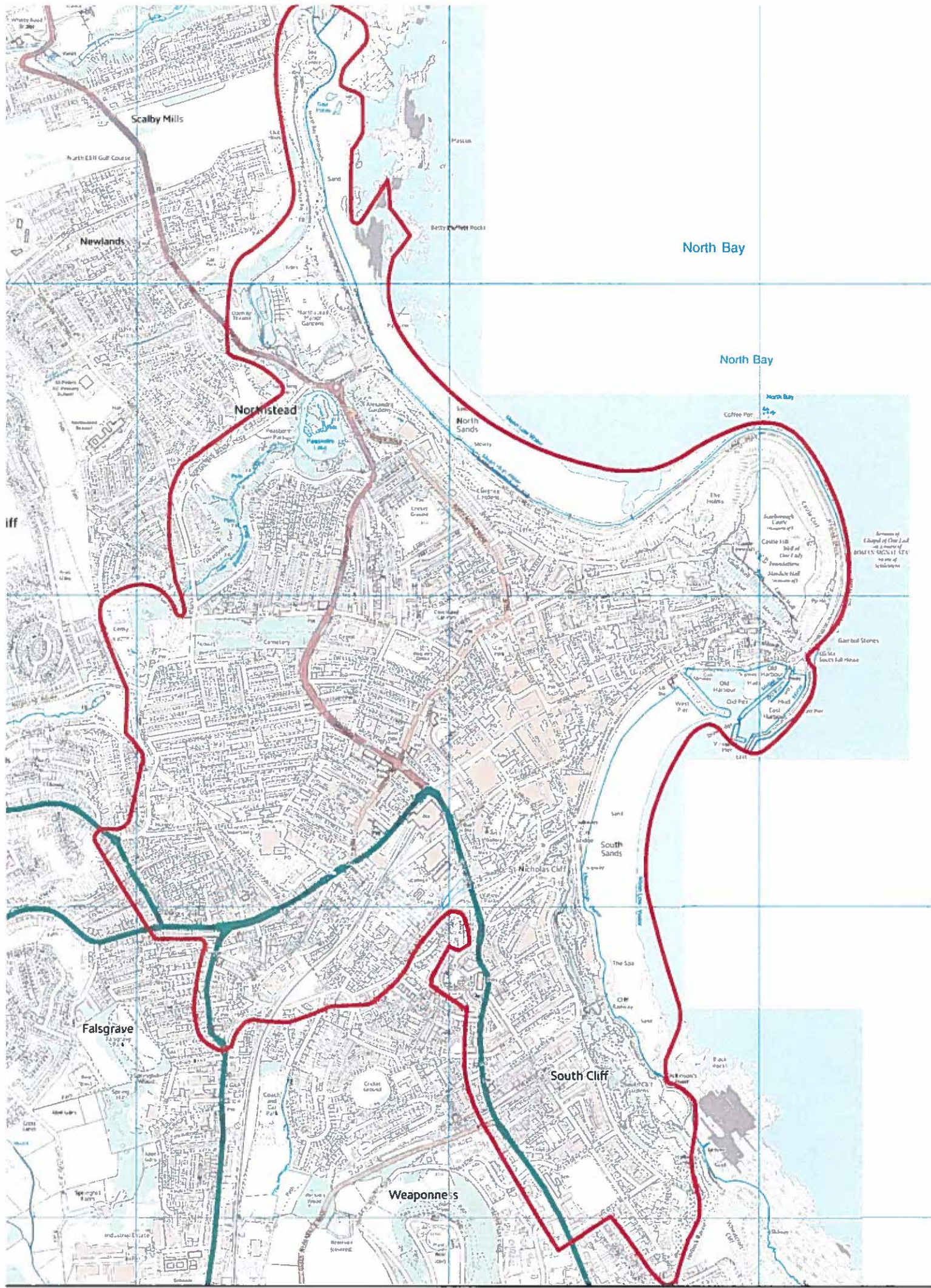
