Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

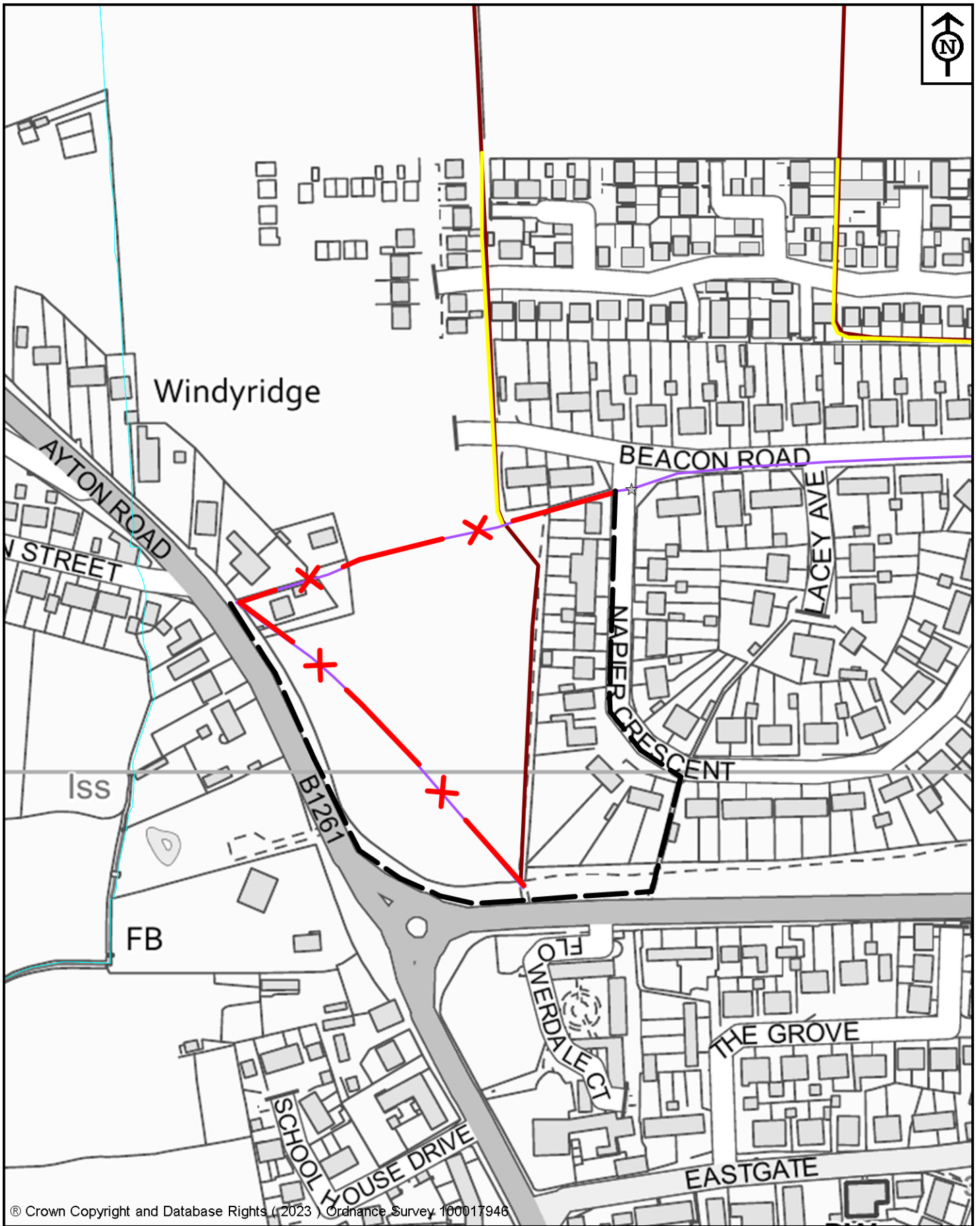
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 30.20/7/1 and 30.20/6/1 in the Parish of Seamer, between grid reference TA01558413 and TA01508394 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 1st November 2023 and 30th April 2024 due to construction works associated with landscaping for the public open space associated with the adjacent development.


The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
