Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleway 05.39/26/3 in the Parish of Sutton-in-Craven, between grid references SE00634359 and SE00634357 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 12 January 2024 and 21 June 2024 due to a damaged bridge. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 429.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.

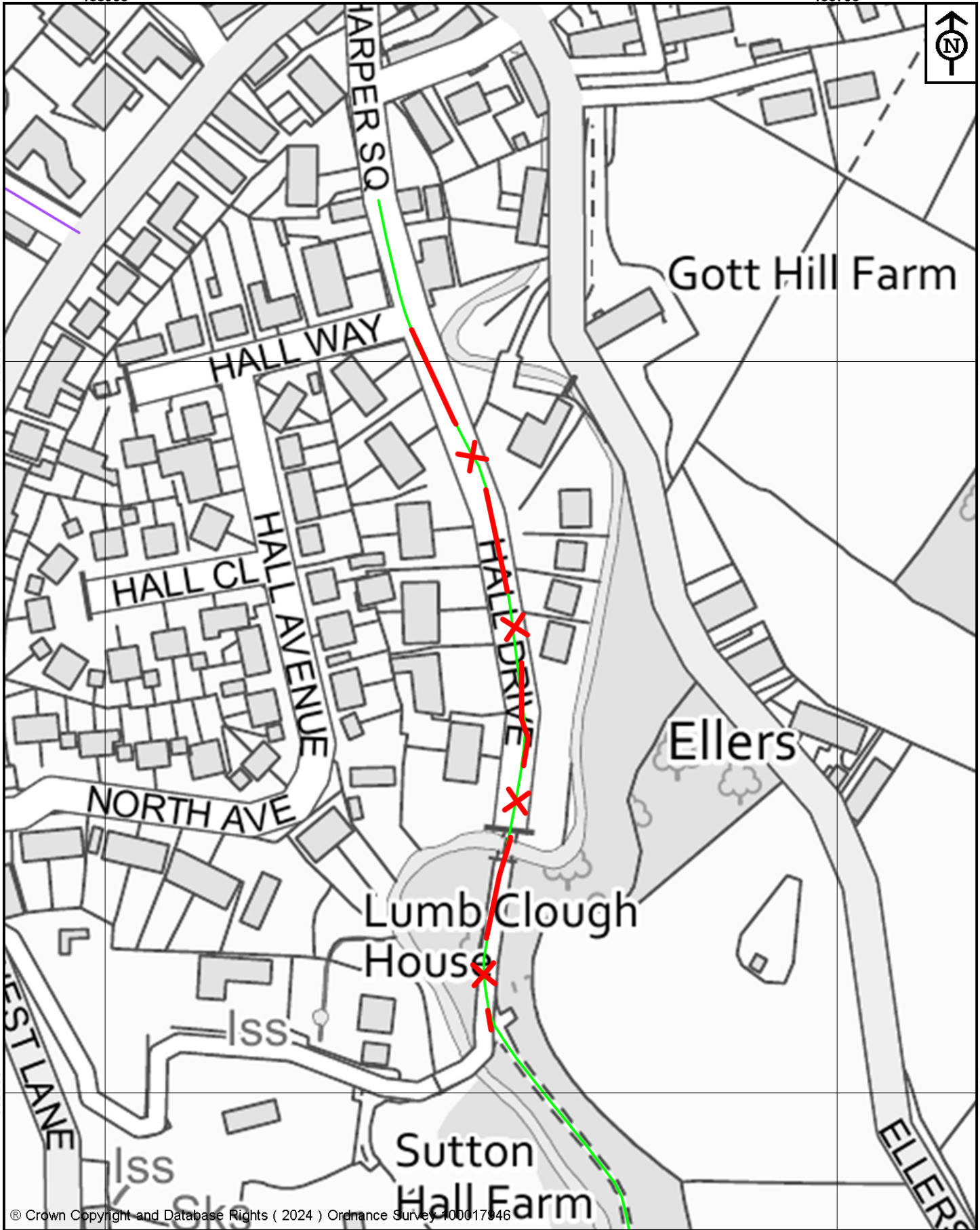
