North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 10.140/5/1 in the Parish of Stokesley, between grid reference NZ52470855 and NZ52470853 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024 and 28<sup>th</sup> August 2024 due to drainage works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
