(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) (CARR LANE, HACKNESS) ORDER 1999

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following order:-

1. Save as provided in article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the unclassified road AN300R, Carr Lane, Hackness, from its southern point at its junction with the C70, Hackness to Snainton road, to its northern point at its junction with the C209, Langdale End to Hackness road.

2. Nothing in article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any motor vehicle to proceed along the road therein specified if the vehicle is being used:-

- (a) for fire brigade, police, or ambulance purposes;
- (b) (i) in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in that road or in land accessible only from that road of any sewer or of any main pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (ii) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;
 - (iii) for the purpose of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.







and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.




