## 3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING AND MATTERS ARISING

- **3.1.** Minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2022 agreed as a true record.
- **3.2.** KB stated that item 4.5 from concerning the Whitby Swing Bridge has been allocated a budget separate to the Towns Fund.

#### 4. INTRODUCTION OF DELIVERY PHASE

## 5. EASTSIDE COMMUNITY HUB
