What is a **Privacy Notice**?

A **privacy notice** tells you how the Council use your personal information

It tells you what we do with your information when you or other people share it with the council.



The **personal information** we may collect is:

- Your name.
- Your contact details such as email address, postal address or telephone number.
- We may ask for your bank account details for expenses claims.
- What you say at meetings and other activities. We will do this by writing notes and minutes of the meetings.
- We might also collect information about whether you use a wheelchair or need an interpreter or other access needs you might have. This helps us make sure activities are accessible for you.
- We might need to know what we need to do to keep everyone safe.











We might get other information such as:

- Sex
- Ethnicity
- Age
- Disability

This information will be anonymous.

Anonymous means we do not know who you are.







Why do we collect personal information?

- To let people know about things that are happening.
- To tell people when there is going to be a meeting, activity or event they might want to be involved in.
- To send people information about what is happening.
- To help us arrange travel and pay travel costs.
