This order is made by The North Yorkshire Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part 3 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely 2022/24168/FUL: a new dwelling at land between Millstone and The Croft Ingleton Carnforth LA6 3BZ. The application proposes the development of a 1.5 storey 2-bedroom house located at a site across the southern most route of the current footpath

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
- There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of The North Yorkshire Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date which The North Yorkshire Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. The Owner is hereby required to pay the cost of carrying out the said works.
- 5. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.




