This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr and Mrs Brown, Newburn, Borrowby, Thirsk, YO7 4QP have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Path into a fit condition for use by the public.


Borrowby Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Newburn, Borrowby and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. There shall from the date of confirmation of this Order be the Public Footpath over the land situated at Newburn, Borrowby shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and thereupon The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by adding the Public Footpath to it.
- 2A. The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.


