## NOSTERFIELD (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order, on one or more of the grounds contained in Section I of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) For improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
- (iii) For preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic in a manner which is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road.

The proposal seeks to revoke the existing 40mph speed limit order of 1986 with subsequent extension order of 2005 in Nosterfield village along the B6267 and replace with a 30mph speed limit.
