How our partnership helps people

We use Gas Safe Charity funding to help older, disabled and vulnerable people by improving gas safety in their homes at times of hardship and urgency. The following types of essential minor work may be carried out using the Grant Scheme funding: gas safety checks, gas servicing, gas boiler repairs, gas boiler replacements, gas boiler combustion analysis and more. Work on the ground is delivered by our network of nearly 200 home improvement agencies.

Mrs M's story

Mrs M was referred by Age UK as she is disabled and had no heating or hot water. Mrs M did not qualify under government's scheme because she lived in a mobile home.

The client had very little savings and was on a low income and so finding the funding for a central heating system was a very sinuous and lengthy process.

The Gas Safe Charity Scheme meant that finally there was enough funding for the gas central heating system. The cost of extra funding leveraged was £3,774 plus the cost of the grant for connection to the gas network.

The outcome for Mrs M was improved health and wellbeing, as the warmth has improved her mobility. She also said she was feeling less depressed and that she could not have done it without the help of Homelife Carlisle and the FILT/GSC scheme.
