Have any analyses shown that the animal may have been exposed to food-borne zoonoses or substances likely to result in residues in meat? If so attach a copy.

1. It is an offence to transport an unfit animal if it is likely to be caused unnecessary suffering.
2. During Collection and Transport, animals must be handled considerately without causing unnecessary pain or distress.
3. Casualty animals should only be transported to the NEAREST available place of slaughter.
4. It is an offence to slaughter an animal for human consumption before the end of the withdrawal period of any medication it has received. Samples may be taken from the carcase for residue testing.
