

NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(HARROGATE, BURN BRIDGE, PANNAL AND KNARESBOROUGH)
(TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (NO 9) ORDER 2010

North Yorkshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 11(1) and (2), 2(1) to 2(4), 3(2), 4(1) 82(2), 83(2), 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART 1

GENERAL

1. (1) When used in this Order each of the following expressions has the meaning assigned to it below:-

"Bus" or "Buses" has the same meaning as in regulation 22(2) of the 2002 Regulations;

"Carriageway" means that part of the Road over which the public have right of way of the passage of Motor Vehicles and excludes any way over which the public have right of way on foot only;

"Column" means a Column in a Schedule or Part of a Schedule referred to or last referred to;

"Delivering" and or "Collecting" in relation to any Goods includes checking the Goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"Driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place (and shall, as appropriate, bear the meaning assigned by Section 142 of the 1984 Act);

"Goods" shall mean items of any description which cannot easily be carried by one person and do not include Goods that are not pre-ordered, shopping, small fragile Goods or cash or other valuable securities which are being collected or delivered from a bank/building society;

"Goods Vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage or haulage of Goods or burden of any description (other than the effects of passengers) or a trailer so constructed or adapted whether or not such Trailer may by superimposition be attached to the Motor Vehicle in such a manner as to cause a substantial part of its weight to be borne by the Motor Vehicle;

"Hackney Carriage" has the same meaning as in section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 as referred to in The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 save further that reference to "plying for hire" shall be excluded from this definition; and "Taxi" shall be construed to the extent that these terms are interchangeable;

"Heavy Commercial Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 138 of the 1984 Act and which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes;

"Invalid Carriage" means a mechanically propelled vehicle not being a specialist Motor Vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 254 kgs and which is specifically designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from severe physical defect or disability and which is used solely for such a person;

"Junction" means, unless otherwise indicated in this Order, the intersection of the general alignment of the boundaries of two roads;

"Length" referring to a Road means a length of road described in a Schedule;

“Local Service” shall mean any licensed scheduled service operated on a regular bus route;

“Loading” and, or “Unloading” means when a Motor Vehicle stops to load or unload Goods and “Loaded” and “Unloaded” shall be construed accordingly;

“Maximum Gross Weight” shall have the meaning given to that expression by regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

“Motor Car” shall mean and include any mechanically propelled vehicle not being a Motor Cycle or an Invalid Carriage, which is constructed itself to carry passengers of which the weight unladen does not normally exceed 3050 kilograms subject always to the inclusion of the extended meaning to this term given in Section 136 of the 1984 Act (and whether or not it is being used for business purposes);

“Motor Cycle” and “Invalid Carriage” have the same meanings respectively as in Section 136(4) of the 1984 Act;

“Motor Vehicle” means any class of mechanically propelled vehicle including Motor Cycles, Motor Cars, Goods Vehicles and car derived vans, and shall bear the extended definition given thereto in Sections 136 and 137 of the 1984 Act (but shall not include any Heavy Commercial Vehicle as defined in Section 138 of the 1984 Act) (and whether or not it is being used for business purposes). Where reference is made to vehicle or Motor Vehicle in the Order these terms shall be deemed to have the same meaning and be interchangeable and to be interpreted accordingly;

“Officer” means an Officer of the Council duly authorised for any purpose;

“Owner” in relation to a Motor Vehicle means the person by whom such Motor Vehicle is kept and used, and shall have the same meaning as in Section 82 of the 1991 Act;

“Paragraph” means a paragraph of the Article in which the word appears unless otherwise stated;

“Passenger Vehicle” means a Motor Vehicle (other than a Motor Cycle, an Invalid Carriage, Goods Vehicle or Heavy Commercial Vehicle) as defined in this Order;

“Pedal Cycle” means a Pedal Cycle which is not propelled by mechanical power (and shall, as appropriate, bear the meaning assigned the Pedal Cycles (Construction and Use) regulations 1983);

“Post Office” and any reference to “post office vehicle” or “postal packets” shall be construed in the context of the Postal Services Act 2000 and the Consequential Amendments Order 2001 (No. 2001/648) and shall include therefore references to “universal service providers” such as Consignia Plc, as the context shall require;

“Registered Keeper” means:-

- (a) the person whose name appears in the Motor Vehicle registration document or book of the Motor Vehicle in whose name the vehicle is registered, or
- (b) a person who has the permanent use of the Motor Vehicle vested in the name of his employer, or in the case of a leased Motor Vehicle in the name of the leasing company;

“Road” means the full width of the highway including the carriageway and footway any other Road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a Road passes;

“Taxi” means a Hackney Carriage in respect of which a licence has been issued pursuant to the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Acts 1847 and 1889 and any private hire vehicle in respect of which a licence has been issued pursuant to the provisions of the

Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Traffic Sign” means a sign or marking of any size colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the 1984 Act;

“the 1984 Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

“the 2002 Regulations” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended);

“Verge” means any part of a Road which is not a carriageway, footway or lay-by;

(2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order, and any reference in this Order to a Schedule is a reference to a Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

2. For the purposes of this Order any reference to a length of Road shall be construed as a reference to the length specified in Column 4 of the Schedules to this Order of the side or sides of Road specified in respect of that length in Column 3 thereof in relation to the Road named in respect of that side or those sides in Column 2 of those Schedules.

PART II

SPEED LIMITS

3. No person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.1 of this Order.
4. No person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road situated within the Zones specified in Schedule 1.2 of this Order.
5. Each length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act. For the avoidance of any doubt, no person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
6. No person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 of this Order.
7. No person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 of this Order.
8. No person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 of this Order.

PART III

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

9. (i) No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any length of road specified in Schedule 6 of this Order.
- (i) No person shall ride or cause to be ridden any Pedal Bicycle or Tricycle on the lengths of road specified in Items 1, 3 and 5 of Schedule 6 of this Order.

PART IV

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING EXCEPT FOR ACCESS

10. Save as provided in Article 11 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any length of road specified in Schedule 7 of this Order.
11. Nothing in Article 10 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 7 of this Order if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - (b)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (ii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties;
 - (iii) For the purpose of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;
 - (iv) To proceed to or from any premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 7 of this Order for the purpose of garaging, servicing or repair;
 - (c) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

PART V

PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – PEDESTRIAN ZONES

12. Save as provided in Article 13 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order between the hours of 10.30am and 4.00pm on any day.
13. Nothing in Article 12 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order between the hours of 10.30am and 4.00pm on any day if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-
- (a) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - (b)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.
 - (d) In connection with the delivery or collection of bullion to any bank premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order with prior agreement from the Police.

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

14. Save as provided in Article 15 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order between the hours of 4.00pm and 10.30am on any day.
15. Nothing in Article 14 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order between the hours of 4.00pm and 10.30am on any day, if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-
- (a) For the Loading and Unloading of Goods for the purposes of servicing premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedules 8 of this Order
 - (b) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - (c)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory

powers or duties;

- (iv) For the purpose of conveying goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;
- (d) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.
- (e) In connection with the delivery or collection of bullion to any bank premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 8 of this Order with prior agreement from the Police.

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

16. Save as provided in Article 17 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order between the hours of 10.30am and 5.00pm on any day.

17. Nothing in Article 16 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order between the hours of 10.30am and 5.00pm on any day if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-

- (a) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
- (b)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties;
- (c) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.
- (d) In connection with the delivery or collection of bullion to any bank premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order with prior agreement from the Police.

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

18. Save as provided in Article 19 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order between the hours of 5.00pm and 10.30am on any day.

19. Nothing in Article 18 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order between the hours of 5.00pm and 10.30am on any day, if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-

- (a) For the Loading and Unloading of Goods for the purposes of servicing premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedules 9 of this Order
- (b) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;

- (c)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties;
 - (iv) For the purpose of conveying goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;
- (d) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.
- (e) In connection with the delivery or collection of bullion to any bank premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 9 of this Order with prior agreement from the Police.

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

20. Save as provided in Article 21 no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in Schedule 10 of this Order at any time.

21. Nothing in Article 20 shall render it unlawful for any Motor Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 10 of this Order if the Motor Vehicle is being used:-

- (a) For the Loading and Unloading of Goods for the purposes of servicing premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 10 of this Order
- (b) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
- (c)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises situated on or adjacent to the scheduled roads;
 - (ii) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (iii) In the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties;
 - (iv) For the purpose of conveying goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;
 - (v) To proceed to or from any premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 10 of this Order for the purpose of garaging, servicing or repair;
- (d) To any registered practitioner, nurse or midwife in connection with his or her professional duties being performed at any premises situated on or adjacent to the aforementioned streets.
- (e) In connection with the delivery or collection of bullion to any bank premises situated on or adjacent any road specified in Schedule 10 of this Order with prior agreement from the

Police.

PART VI

ONE WAY STREETS

22. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Vehicle or Pedal Cycle to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in Column 2 of Schedule 11 of this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 3 of that Schedule.
23. Nothing in Article 22 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle or Pedal Cycle to proceed in any of the lengths of road to which that Article applies otherwise than in the direction prescribed by that Article if it is necessary to do so to enable:-
- (i) the Vehicle or Pedal Cycle to be used for the removal of any obstruction to traffic, or
 - (ii) the Vehicle or Pedal Cycle to be used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes, or
 - (iii) the Vehicle or Pedal Cycle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, wire or cable or any apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
24. Nothing in Article 22 shall render it unlawful for any person to proceed on a Pedal Cycle along the lengths of road specified in Items 54, 68 and 72 of Schedule 11 in a direction other than that specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.

PART VII

PRESCRIBED ROUTES

25. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Vehicle proceeding in any of the lengths of road and in a direction specified in Column 2 of Schedule 12 of this Order to proceed in any direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 3 of that Schedule.
26. Nothing in Article 25 shall render it unlawful for any person to proceed on a Pedal Cycle along the lengths of road specified in Items 1 and 3 of Schedule 12 in a direction other than that specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.

PART VIII

PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN MOVEMENTS

27. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle or Pedal Cycle proceeding in any of the roads specified in Column 2 of Schedule 13 of this Order to make a right turn into that road specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.

PART IX

PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN MOVEMENTS

28. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle or Pedal Cycle proceeding in any of the roads specified in Column 2 of Schedule 14 of this Order to make a left turn into that road specified in Column 3 of that Schedule.

PART X

PROHIBITION OF BUSES

29. Save as provided by Article 30 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Bus to proceed in either direction in any length of road specified in Schedule 15 of this Order at any time.
30. Nothing in Article 29 shall render it unlawful for any Bus to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 15 of this Order which is:-
- (a) being used for the provision of a Local scheduled Service along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 15 of this Order;
 - (b) proceeding to or from any premises situated on the roads specified in Schedule 15 for the purposes of setting down or picking up passengers.

PART XI

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

7.5 Tonnes

31. Save as provided in Article 32 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Heavy Commercial Vehicle to proceed in either direction, along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 16 of this Order.
32. (i) Nothing in Article 31 shall render it unlawful for any Heavy Commercial Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 16 of this Order if the vehicle is being used:-
- (a) for or in connection with the loading and unloading of Goods or merchandise at any premises or on adjacent to that road or length of road;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture on any land adjacent to that road or length of road or for or in connection with the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon any such land, or
 - (c) in connection with the carrying out of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) removal of any obstruction to traffic,
 - (i) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (d) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;

- (e) to proceed to or from any premises at which the Vehicle on that occasion is to be or has been garaged, serviced or repaired;
 - (f) in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties of that Authority;
 - (g) for the purpose of access to or from any premises on or adjacent to any other public road which has a junction with the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.
- (ii) In this Article any reference to premises or land is a reference to premises or land, in whole or in part, to which access for Heavy Commercial Vehicles can be obtained by means only of a road specified or referred to in Article 31 of this Order and any reference to the carrying out of any operations is a reference to the carrying out of such operations on any premises, land or road specified in Article 32 of this Order.

PART XII

WIDTH RESTRICTIONS

33. Save as provided in Article 34 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden cause or permit any Vehicle, the width of which, inclusive or any load on the Vehicle exceeds 6 feet 6 inches to proceed in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 17 of this Order.
34. Nothing in Article 33 shall render it unlawful for any Vehicle to proceed along any road specified in Schedule 17 of this Order if the vehicle is being used:-
- (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road; or
 - (b) In connection with any building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any such roads or any part thereof or the laying, erection, alteration, repair or maintenance in or adjacent to any such roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

PART XIII

BOX JUNCTIONS

35. In this Order, reference to a boxed area is reference to the area of carriageway of the road specified in the schedule to this Order, being an area at or near the junction of two or more of those carriageways marked by traffic signs consisting of cross-hatched yellow lines bounded by a yellow line placed on the carriageway, in accordance with Diagrams 1043 and 1044 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (as amended) and authorised by the Secretary of State under Section 64(1) of the said Act of 1984.
36. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive a vehicle into a boxed area and thereafter drive it in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any of the vehicle to remain at rest within the area, in any of the lengths or road specified in Schedule 18 of this Order:
- Provided that no driver of a vehicle which is caused to remain at rest within the area shall be guilty of an offence if at the time he drove into that area he had reasonable cause to believe that he would immediately thereafter be able to drive the vehicle wholly out of the area.
37. Nothing in Article 36 of this Order shall apply:
- (a) so as to prohibit the driving of a vehicle into a boxed area by a person who thereafter drives it to a position where he can conveniently wait to make a right turn and who is then

prevented from driving out of the area by reason only of the presence of other stationary vehicles in or near the area waiting to complete a right turn, or

- (b) in relation to vehicles used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or civil defence purposes.

PART XIV

PROHIBITION OF CYCLING

- 38. No person shall ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle on any of the lengths of footpaths specified in Schedule 19 of this Order.

PART XV

REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDERS

- 39. The Traffic Regulation Orders specified in Column 1 of Schedule 20 to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified in Column 2 of that Schedule, and to the extent that the provisions of this Order are inconsistent with, or incompatible with, the provisions of any other Order, Byelaws or enactment relating to traffic regulation in Harrogate, Burn Bridge, Pannal and Knaresborough, area not specifically referred to in Schedule 20, the provisions of this Order shall prevail for all purposes.

PART XVI

OPERATION OF THE ORDER

- 40. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 41. This Order shall come into operation on 3 May 2010 and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (Harrogate, Burn Bridge, Pannal and Knaresborough) (Traffic Management) (No.9) Order 2010".
