Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along Hollgate Lane, Hackness, from its junction with Lowdales Lane in a north-westerly direction to a point immediately east of Broxa Farm.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any motor vehicle to proceed along the road therein specified if the vehicle is being used:-

- (a) for fire brigade, police, or ambulance purposes;
- (b) (i) in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road or any part thereof or the laying erection alteration or repair in that road or in land accessible only from that road of any sewer or of any main pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (ii) in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;
  - (iii) for the purpose of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road;

and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 26 March 1994 and may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Driving Except for Access) (Hollgate Lane, Hackness) Order 1994.






