

British Standard 5837: 2005 'Trees in relation to construction – Recommendations'

This standard provides recommendations and guidance for arboriculturalists, architects, builders, engineers, land managers, landscape architects and contractors, planners, statutory undertakers, surveyors, and all others interested in harmony between trees and construction. This standard supersedes BS 5837: 1991 'A Guide for trees in relation to construction'.

The Council will apply the guidance and recommendations in this standard when assessing development proposals that affect trees on development sites. Failure to properly assess the arboricultural aspects of development proposals in line with this standard may lead to delays in the process of planning applications. You are therefore advised to seek professional arboricultural advice at an early stage in the application process.
