NOTICE OF DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4 OF THE TOWN  
AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER  
1980 RESTRICTING PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT.

RYEDALE DISTRICT COUNCIL

Development Order 1980

Direction under Article 4

A site of approximately 190 acres of land approximately one mile south of Wombleton and one mile east of Harome. The eastern boundary of the disused airfield is formed by the Wombleton to Nunnington road with agricultural land beyond, the southern boundary is marked by Harome Moor Drain and a field access road, with agricultural land beyond. The western boundary follows an agricultural field boundary. To the north the site is bounded by a caravan site and scrap yard and agricultural land.

Notice is hereby given that the Ryedale District Council have made a direction under Article 4 of the above-mentioned order relating to a site of approximately 190 acres of land approximately one mile south of Wombleton and one mile east of Harome with respect to development described in the Town & County Planning General Development Order 1980 Schedule 1 Class IV 2.

The effect of the direction is that the permission granted under Article 3 of the above-mentioned Order shall not apply to development within the said Class IV 2 and described therein as follows.

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the purpose of motor car or motor-cycle racing or for the purpose of the holding of markets), and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use.

Provided that for the purpose of the limitation imposed on the number of days on which land may be used for motor car or motor-cycle racing, account shall be taken only of those days on which races are held or practising takes place.

and the said development shall not be carried out on the said land unless permission is granted by the Local Planning Authority on an application made in that behalf.

A copy of the direction and of the map defining the area of land to which the direction relates may be seen at the offices of the said Council at Ryedale House, Malton, at all reasonable hours.

And notice is hereby given that on the 12th day of April 1983 The Secretary of State for the Environment approved the said direction and the said direction will come into force on the date of first publication of this notice.


