(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (WELBURN) ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that the North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on the length of road at Welburn specified below:-

Column 1 Item	Columns 2 Road	Column 3 Length
1	Chestnut Avenue, Welburn	From the centre line of its junction with the A64, northwards for a distance of 802.5 metres.
