(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend "North Yorkshire Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Richmondshire) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

SCHEDULE 2 REVOCATIONS

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Nature of Restriction
Richmond	Frances Road	South	From opposite the boundary line of No 5 and No 7 Frances Road	East for 6.6 metres and west for 6.6 metres (two bays)	Disabled Bay
