ORDER 2023 NO 180

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using Public Bridleways 10.150/36/1 Thirsk and 10.135/5/1 South Kilvington, between grid references SE42258423 and SE42448414 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 9th May 2023 and 17th October 2023 due to an unsafe bridge. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 132 which commenced on 18th April 2023.

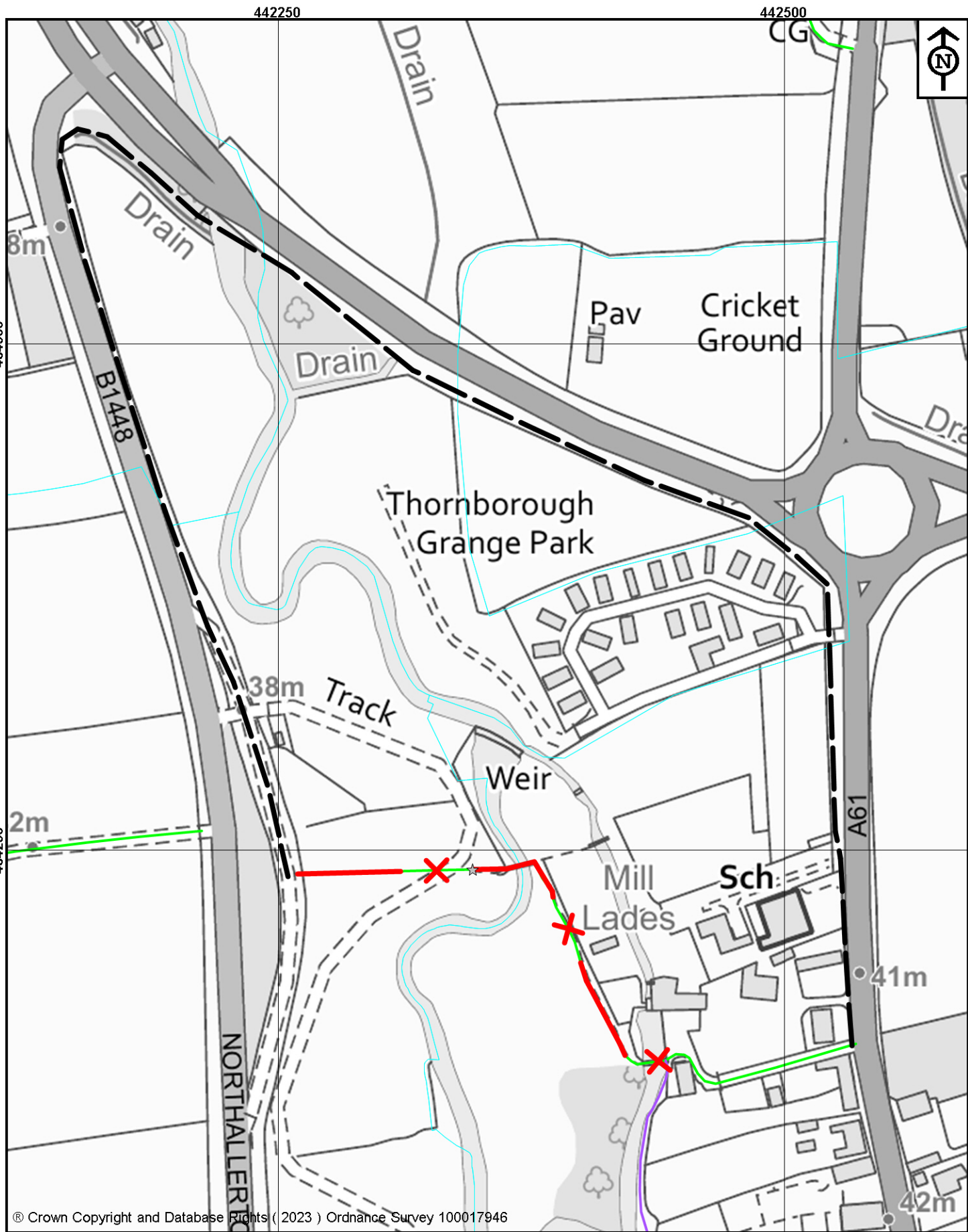
The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.
