3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING (ATTACHED) AND MATTERS ARISING

3.1. Minutes of the meeting held on 2nd February agreed as true record.

- **3.3.** LS provided a brief update on the Local Walking and Cycling improvements project. The team carrying out this project and the Wildeye team are working collaboratively to see where their work can complement each other.

4. SCARBOROUGH TOWN CENTRE TEAM – RICHARD GRUNWELL

- **4.1.** RG provided an update on the work of the Scarborough Town Centre Team (TCT) and the future plans of the team.
