(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BEDALE ROAD, AISKEW) ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that on 1st August 2023 North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road at Bedale Road, Aiskew specified below.

Description of Roads Affected

40 MPH Speed Limit

ITEM	ROAD	LENGTH
1.	C426	From the existing 30mph terminal signs in Aiskew to the 30mph terminal signs in Leeming Bar, for a distance of 895 metres measured along its centre line
2.	Leeming Services Link Road	From the existing 30mph terminal signs in Aiskew to the derestricted terminal signs at the A6055 roundabout adjacent to Leeming Bar Services, for a distance of approximately 750 metres measured along its centre line
