THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (A684 LEYBURN) ORDER 2023

The North Yorkshire Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule 1 hereto.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule 2 hereto.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on \$TBC and may be cited as "The North Yorkshire Council (30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limits) (A684 Leyburn) Order 2023 ".
- This Order revokes Items 1 and 7 in the following traffic regulation order: "North Yorkshire County Council (30mph/40mph Speed Limits) (A684, Leyburn) Order 2017".
