# (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (SKIPTON ROAD, LIDGET ROAD & INGS LANE, BRADLEY) ORDER 2023

The North Yorkshire Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
- 2. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on \$TBC and may be cited as "The North Yorkshire Council (20 mph Speed Limit) (Skipton Road, Lidget Road & Ings Lane, Bradley) Order 2023 ".
- 4. North Yorkshire County Council (20mph Speed Limit) (Skipton Road, Bradley) Order 2002 is hereby revoked in its entirety.

Ings Lane, Bradley	From its junction with Lidget Road to a point 35 metres west of its junction with Matthew Lane measured from the centre line of Matthew Lane.
