

## THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

### (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (SKIPTON ROAD, LIDGET ROAD & INGS LANE, BRADLEY) ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

Roads	Lengths
Skipton Road, Bradley	From a point 44 metres South East of its northern junction with Heath Crescent measured from the centre line of Heath Crescent, to its junction with Ings Lane.
Lidget Road, Bradley	From a point 13 metres west of its junction with College Road measured from the centre line of College Road to its junction with Ings Lane.
Ings Lane, Bradley	From its junction with Lidget Road to a point 35 metres west of its junction with Matthew Lane measured from the centre line of Matthew Lane.
