IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER A HISTORIC EVENT UNDER SCHEDULE 3 OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006

MUKER EDGE, MUKER (CL 29) RIGHT ENTRY 40

An application has been made to North Yorkshire Council by Malcolm Thomas Raw, Raymond Stephen Raw and Dr Kathleen Anne Raw under Schedule 3 (3)(c) of the Commons Act 2006. The application seeks to record a historic severance of the rights of common registered at right entry number 40 of common land unit CL 29, known as Muker Edge.

The Registration Authority is satisfied that the application complies with the requirements of Schedule 3(3)(c) of the Commons Act 2006 and Schedule 4 Paragraph 19 of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 with regard to 55 ½ sheep rights registered at right entry no. 40 and listed as being attached to land known as Church View Farm. In consequence, the Commons Registration Authority has determined that the application be granted.

The Registration Authority has therefore amended right entry 40 of the Rights Section of the Common Land Register unit number CL 29, in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 to reflect the severance of the rights of common previously attached to land known as Church View Farm registered at right entry 40 and becoming rights held in gross. It is not possible to sever an unquantifiable right of cutting and carrying away peat and therefore this right will remain registered in the names of Christopher William Raw and Thomas Spensley Raw and as being attached to the dwelling Church View Farm.
