

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(MILFORD ROAD, SHERBURN IN ELMET) ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

Road	Length
Milford Road, Sherburn in Elmet.	From existing 40mph sign board which is 51m south from centreline of New Lane Junction To a point 335m south onto Milford Road which is 102.20m south from the centreline of Athelstan Community Primary School junction.
