PROPOSED CREATION OF 30mph SPEED LIMIT: Milford Road, Sherburn in Elmet.

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order on one or more of the grounds contained in Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- 1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising,
- 2. for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,
- 3. for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic in a manner which is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road.

The proposal seeks to achieve the following:

Milford Road, Sherburn in Elmet.

- The implementation of a 30mph speed limit from the existing 40mph signs at the south side
 of the village for 335m to a point 102.20m south from the centreline of Athelstan
 Community Primary School junction at the south side of the village.
- The proposals are illustrated on Milford Road, Sherburn in Elmet.
