

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) (MARKET PLACE, PICKERING)
ORDER 2024

The North Yorkshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along Market Place, Pickering.
2. Nothing in article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any motor vehicle to proceed along the road therein specified if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for fire brigade, police, or ambulance purposes;
 - (b)
 - (i) in connection with any wedding or funeral taking place from or at premises fronting that road;
 - (ii) in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that road or any part thereof or the laying erection alteration or repair in that road or in land accessible only from that road of any sewer or of any main pipe, cable or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any electronic communications network or electronic communications service as defined in Schedule 3A and Section 32 of the Communications Act 2003;
 - (iii) in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;
 - (iv) for the purpose of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from premises or land adjacent to that road,
 - (v) by a universal service provider in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.
3. The Council are satisfied that for the following reasons it is requisite that Section 3(1)(b) of the Act should not apply in relation to this Order: -
 - (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
 - (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
 - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
 - (d) by a universal service provider in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties;
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

5. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any motor vehicle to proceed along the road therein specified during the hours prescribed in that article if the vehicle is being driven by-
 - (a) a resident of Market Place, Pickering;
 - (b) a residential guest of a hotel in Market Place, Pickering
6. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a security carrier to proceed along the road therein specified during the hours prescribed in that article.
7. "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm Each Monday Except For Access) (Market Place, Pickering) Order 2009 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
8. This Order shall come into operation on 5th February 2024 and may be cited as "The North Yorkshire Council (Prohibition of Driving Except for Access) (Market Place, Pickering) Order 2023".
