(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A162 & B1222, SHERBURN IN ELMET)
ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Part 1 and Part 2 below:-

Part 1

Road	Length
A162	from the southern exit of the roundabout with the A162/B1222/Moor Lane, Sherburn in Elmet south for 316m
A162	from the northern exit of the roundabout with the A162/B1222/Moor Lane, Sherburn in Elmet north for 330m

Part 2

Road	Length
B1222	from the eastern exit of the roundabout with the A162, Sherburn in Elmet for 2021m
