IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER A HISTORIC EVENT UNDER SCHEDULE 3 OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006

WEST STONESDALE MOOR (CL 151) RIGHT ENTRY 12(1)

An application has been made to North Yorkshire Council by Mark Robert Rukin and Linda Elizabeth Rukin under Schedule 3 (3)(c) of the Commons Act 2006. The application seeks to record a historic severance of the rights of common registered at right entry number 12(1) of common land unit CL 151, known as West Stonesdale Moor.

The Registration Authority is satisfied that the application complies with the requirements of Schedule 3(3)(c) of the Commons Act 2006 and Schedule 4 Paragraph 19 of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 with regard to the right to graze 235 sheep, 79 hogs and 1 horse and 6 cattle for the period from 12 May to 31 August in each year, over the whole of the land comprised of register unit CL151, registered at right entry no. 12(1) and listed as being attached to land known as Gatehouse Farm, West Stonesdale Farm. In consequence, the Commons Registration Authority has determined that the application be granted.

The Registration Authority has therefore amended right entry 12(1) of the Rights Section of the Common Land Register unit number CL 151, in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 to reflect the severance of the rights of common previously attached to land known as Gateshouse Farm registered at right entry 12(1) and becoming rights held in gross. It is not possible to sever an unquantifiable right to cut and take away turf and therefore this right will remain registered in the names of Paul Hallam and Susan Hallam and as being attached to the dwelling Gateshouse Farm.
