(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 2 February 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

Main Street, Staxton from its junction with Ings Lane to its junction with Staxton Carr Lane.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 29 February 2024, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Scarborough Library, Vernon Road, Scarborough YO11 2NN during normal office hours from 14 February 2024 until 15 March 2024 and also viewed online at <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map> or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 16 February 2024 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
