(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(HYMAS COURT, BURTON LEONARD) (AMENDMENT NO 42)
ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that on 26 January 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Harrogate) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

1	Hymas Court, Burton Leonard, Harrogate	South east	From a point 124m east of its junction with Copgrove Road (C377) for a distance of 23m in a north easterly direction
2	Hymas Court, Burton Leonard, Harrogate	North west	From a point 124m east of its junction with Copgrove Road (C377) to a point 147m east of its junction with Copgrove Road
3	Hymas Court, Burton Leonard, Harrogate	South west	From its junction with the main arm of Hymas Court for a distance of 21.9m in a north westerly direction
4	Hymas Court, Burton Leonard, Harrogate	North east	From its junction with the main arm of Hymas court for a distance of 21.9m in a north westerly direction

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 26 January 2024 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
