PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF WAITING RESTRICTION NORTH END, BEDALE

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order, on one or more of the grounds contained in Section I of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) For improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
- (iii) For facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic.

The proposal seeks to introduce a 'No Waiting at any time' restriction on North End, Bedale.

The proposal seeks to improve accessibility for residents and businesses within the area.

Bedale	B6285, North End	South/East	A point measured 16m back from the mouth of the junction between the B6285 and the U1472 around its radius, for a distance of 42m in a South-easternly direction along the B6285.
Bedale	U1472	North/East	A point measured 30m back from the mouth of the junction between the B6285 and the U1472 around its radius, for a distance of 10m in a North-westerly direction along the B6285.
