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This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner(s) of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Path(s) should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that The North York Moors National Park Within North Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The Most Honourable Constantine Edmund Walter, Marquis of Normanby, Mulgrave Castle, Lythe, Whitby, YO21 3RJ has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Path(s) into a fit condition for use by the public.

Egton Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Dowson Garth, Egton and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority and thereupon The North York Moors National Park Within North Yorkshire Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be the Public Footpaths over the land situated at Dowson Garth, Egton described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon The North York Moors National Park Within North Yorkshire Definitive Map shall be modified by adding the Public Footpaths to it.
- 2A. The North York Moors National Park Within North Yorkshire Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: Pedestrian gates to BS5709:2018 to be provided at Points E, G, J & K as shown on the Order Plan and a culvert to be provided at Point F as shown on the Order Plan.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.



The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Footpaths as follows. Public Footpath 30.33/087 between NZ 8156 0373 & NZ 8139 0355 will be diverted onto a new route to the east of Dowson Garth between NZ 8158 0374 & NZ 8156 0349. Public Footpath 30.33/091 between NZ 8155 0351 & NZ 8151 0360 will be diverted onto a new route between NZ 8155 0351 & NZ 8139 0355.
