Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Bridleways 10.150/36/1 Thirsk and 10.135/5/1 South Kilvington, between grid references SE42258423 and SE42448414, due to an unsafe bridge, has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 17th October 2025 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

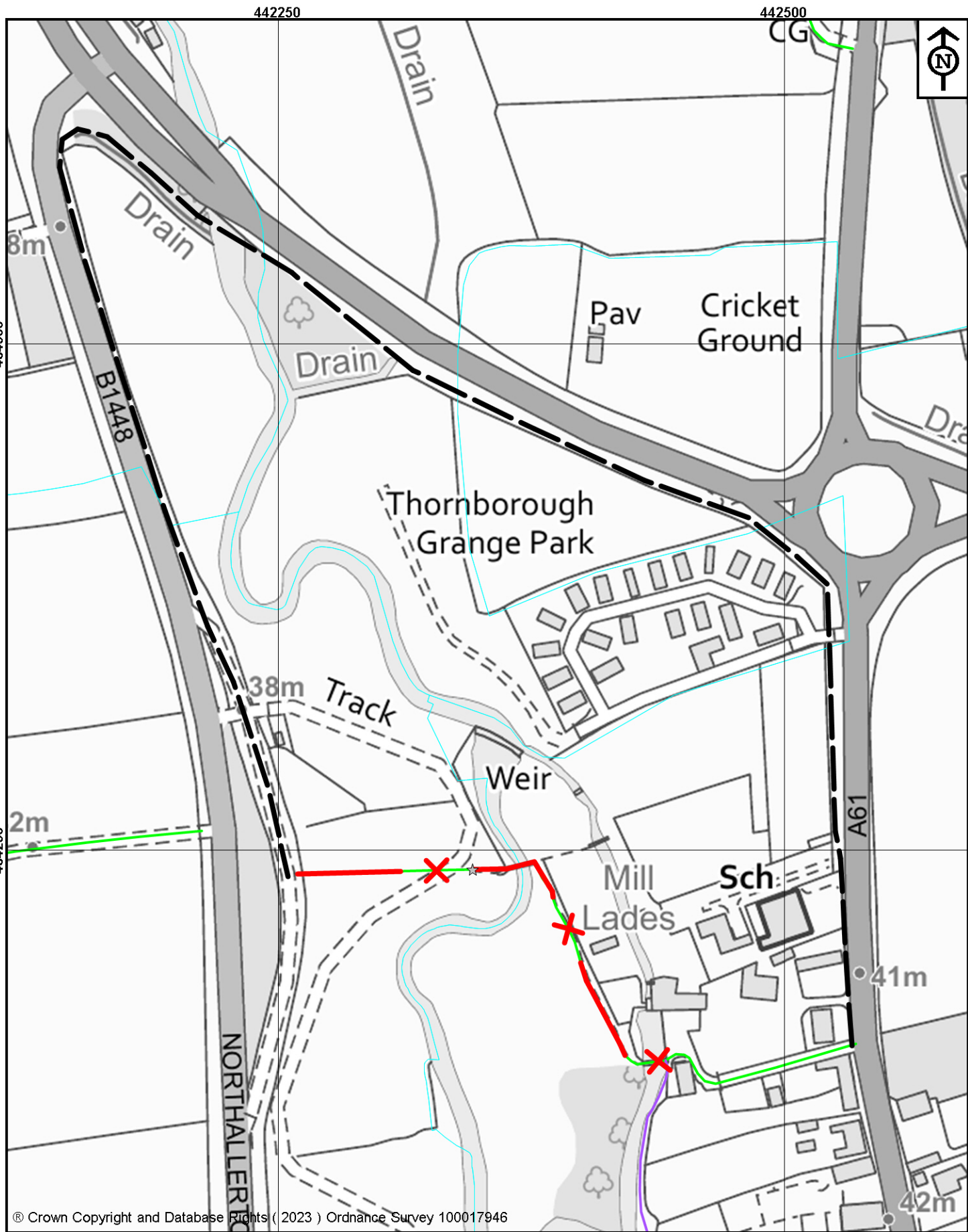
The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs. An alternative route will be signed on site.
