



Application for the Temporary Closure of Footpath, Bridleway, Restricted Byway or Byway Open to all Traffic under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Before filling out this application form please make sure you read the guidance notes.

I/We the undersigned hereby request that the North Yorkshire Council make an order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to temporarily close a Public Right of Way ('path') in accordance with the details set out below.

I enclose a copy of a plan indicating:

- 1) the section of the path to be closed in brown
- 2) the proposed temporary alternative route of the path in purple (where applicable)

Please be aware if your works involve placing apparatus in the highway by a private contractor, a Section 50 license may be required. A Section 50 license covers any works to private drains and sewers as well as private gas, electricity, and water services.

Similarly, if a private contractor wants to excavate in the highway without placing apparatus, for example trial holes, a Section 171 license is required.
