Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

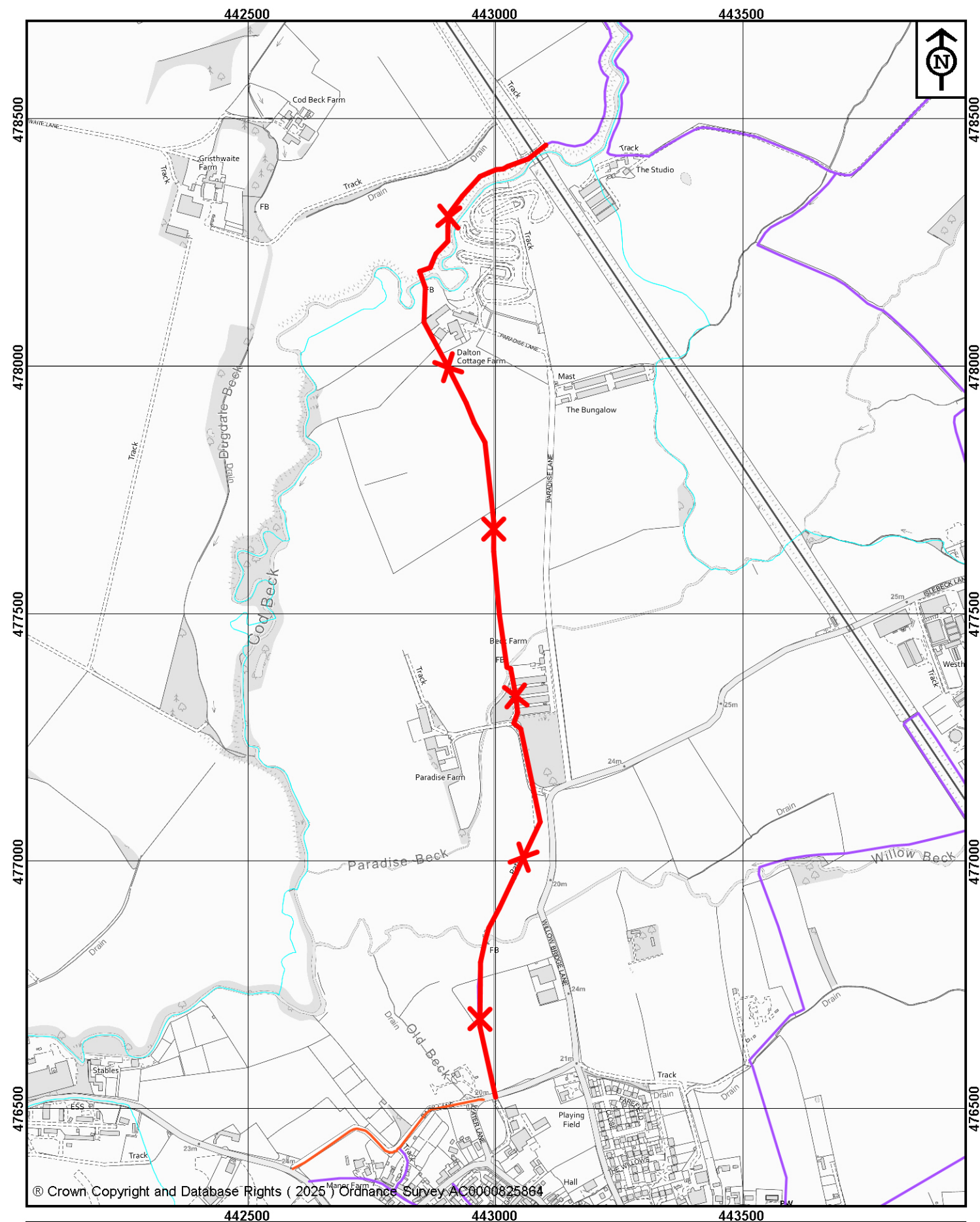
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath 10.36/1/1 in the Parish of Dalton, between grid reference SE43077714 and SE43107845, for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025 and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2025 due to an unsafe footbridge.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs
