

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL
(20 MPH AND 30MPH SPEED LIMITS)
(VARIOUS ROADS, CHURCH FENTON)
ORDER 2025

The North Yorkshire Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby order as follows:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified Part 2 of the Schedule hereto.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 19 May 2025 and may be cited as "The North Yorkshire Council (20 mph and 30 mph Speed Limits) (Various Roads, Church Fenton) Order 2025".
5. The North Yorkshire County Council 30mph and 40mph Speed Limits (Various Roads in Church Fenton and Ulleskelf) Order 2009 item numbers 5, 6, 8 and 9 are revoked in their entirety.

SCHEDULE 1

ROADS IN THE PARISH OF CHURCH FENTON

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Main Street	From its junction with Station Road / Oakwood Close to its junction with Northfield Lane.
2.	Main Street	Form its junction with Northfield Lane for a distance of 90 metres in an easterly direction.
3.	Church Street (C312)	From its junction with Station Road / Main Street for a distance of 93 metres in a southerly direction.
4.	Northfield Lane	Full length.

ROADS IN THE PARISH OF CHURCH FENTON

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

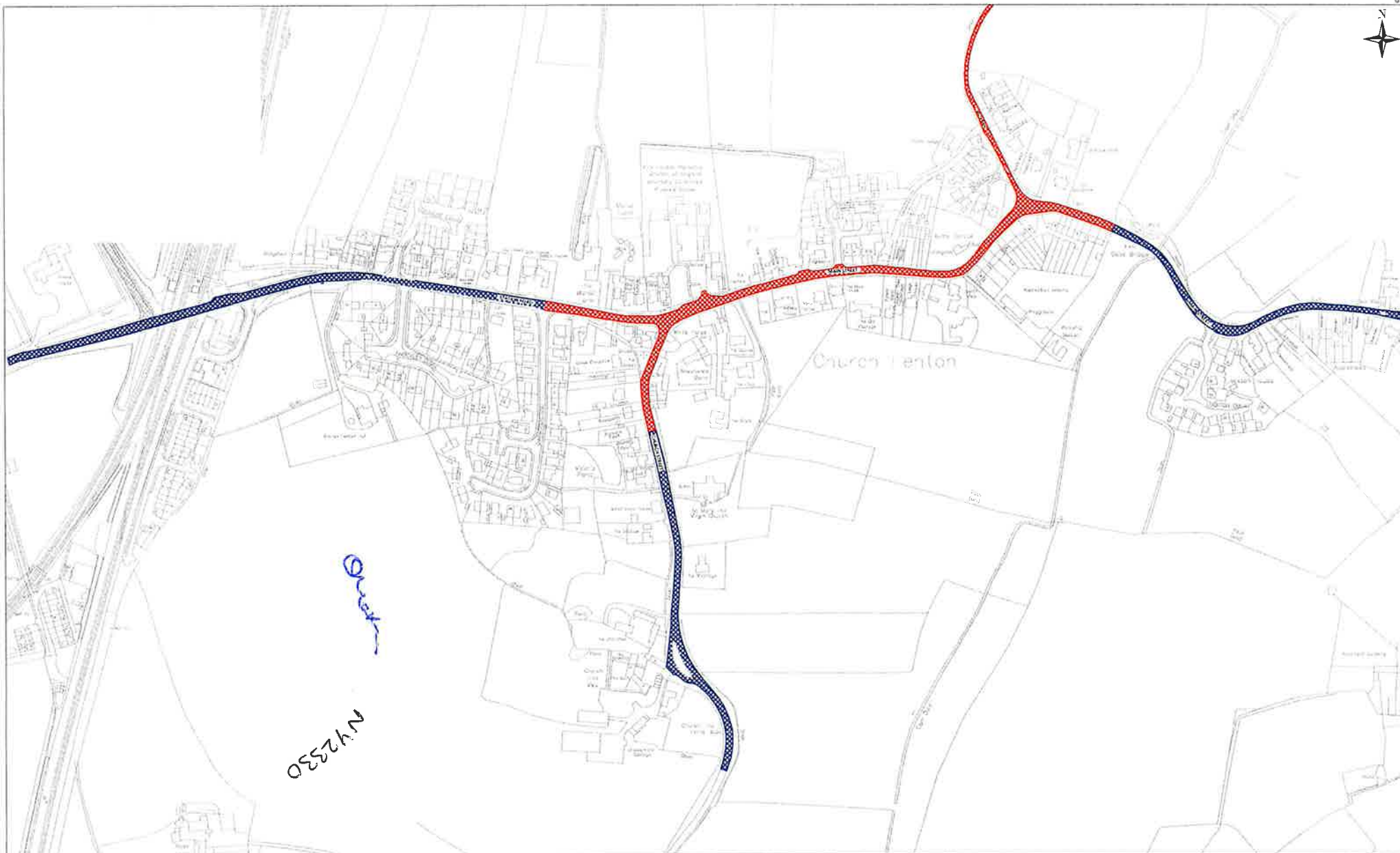
<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Main Street	From its junction with Northfield Lane to its junction with Busk Lane.
2.	Church Street (C312) including service road at Church End Farm	From a point 93 metres south of its junction with Main Street / Station Road for a distance of 357 metres in a southerly direction.
3.	Station Road	From its junction with Oakwood Close to a point 140 metres west of Sandwath Lane.
