2.	Menwith Hill Road (C252/1/40)	In its entirety from its junction with the B6451 to its junction with Stumps Lane (U3287/2/30).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 09 May 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
