(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO 60) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on 16 May 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the tables below:-

SCHEDULE 1

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING EXCEPT FOR TAXIS

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Nature of Restriction
Selby	Micklegate	South East	A point 6m West of junction Wren Lane	For 18m South East	Area of carriageway reserved for taxis between 6pm and 8am

SCHEDULE 2

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Nature of Restriction
Selby	Micklegate	South East	A point 6m West of junction Wren Lane	For 18m South East	Parking – 20minutes no return within 1 hour

SCHEDULE 3

LOADING/UNLOADING ONLY AT ALL TIMES

Location	Road	Side	From	To
Selby	Market Lane	North	A point 8.5 metres West of the junction with James Street	15m West
Selby	Market Lane	North	A point 30 metres West of the junction with James Street	11m West

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 16 May 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
