(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (HOWDEN ROAD, BARLBY) **ORDER 2025**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 30 May 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

Road	Length
Howden Road, Barlby	Howden Road, Barlby from the junction with Church Lane Eastbound until the junction with Pindars Way

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 9 June 2025, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Barlby Library and Community Hub, Howden Road, Barlby, YO8 5JE during normal office hours from 5 June 2025 until 11 July 2025 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 30 May 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
