

## THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

### **(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A6136 CATTERICK ROAD, BROUGH WITH ST GILES)** **ORDER 2025**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 6 June 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

1	A6136 Catterick Road, Brough with St Giles)	From a point 97.5 metres north east of its junction with the easternmost part of the splitter island on the east side of the roundabout at the junction with the road leading southwards to Tunstall at Brough With St Giles for a distance of 39.5 metres in a north easterly direction (measured along the centre line of the carriageway)
2	Road Leading Southwards to Tunstall	From its junction with the southernmost side of the splitter island on the south side of the roundabout at the junction with the A6136 Catterick Road at Brough with St Giles for a distance of 39 metres in a southerly direction (measured along the centre line of the carriageway)

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 6 June 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
