(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (HOWDEN ROAD, BARLBY) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 25 07 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along any length of road specified in column 2 of the following table in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 3 of that table.

ONE WAY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION

| Column 1 Item | Column 2 Road | Column 3 Permitted Direction |
|--------------------------|--|---|
| 1. | Howden Road, Barlby from the junction with Church Lane | Eastbound until the junction with Pindars Way |

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 04 08 2025, together with a map showing the road affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Howden Library and Community Hub, Howden Road, Barlby, YO8 5JE during normal office hours from 31 07 2025 until 05 09 2025 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 25 07 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
