# (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (GATE HELMSLEY VILLAGE) ORDER 1999

North Yorkshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby order as follows:-

- 1. The length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule hereto.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. This Order may be cited as "North Yorkshire County Council (30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limits) (Gate Helmsley Village) Order 1999" and shall come into operation on 8 March 1999.

## **SCHEDULE**

## Roads in the Village of Gate Helmsley

### Part 1

## 30 mph Speed Limit

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Item	Road	Length
1	Back Lane	For its entire length, i.e. from the A166 to the Gate Helmsley to Upper Helmsley road.

#### Part 2

#### 40 mph Speed Limit

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Item	Road	Length
2	A166, York to Bridlington road	From a point 160 metres west of Back Lane to a point 290 metres east of the Gate Helmsley to Upper Helmsley road for a distance of approximately 1 kilometre.
