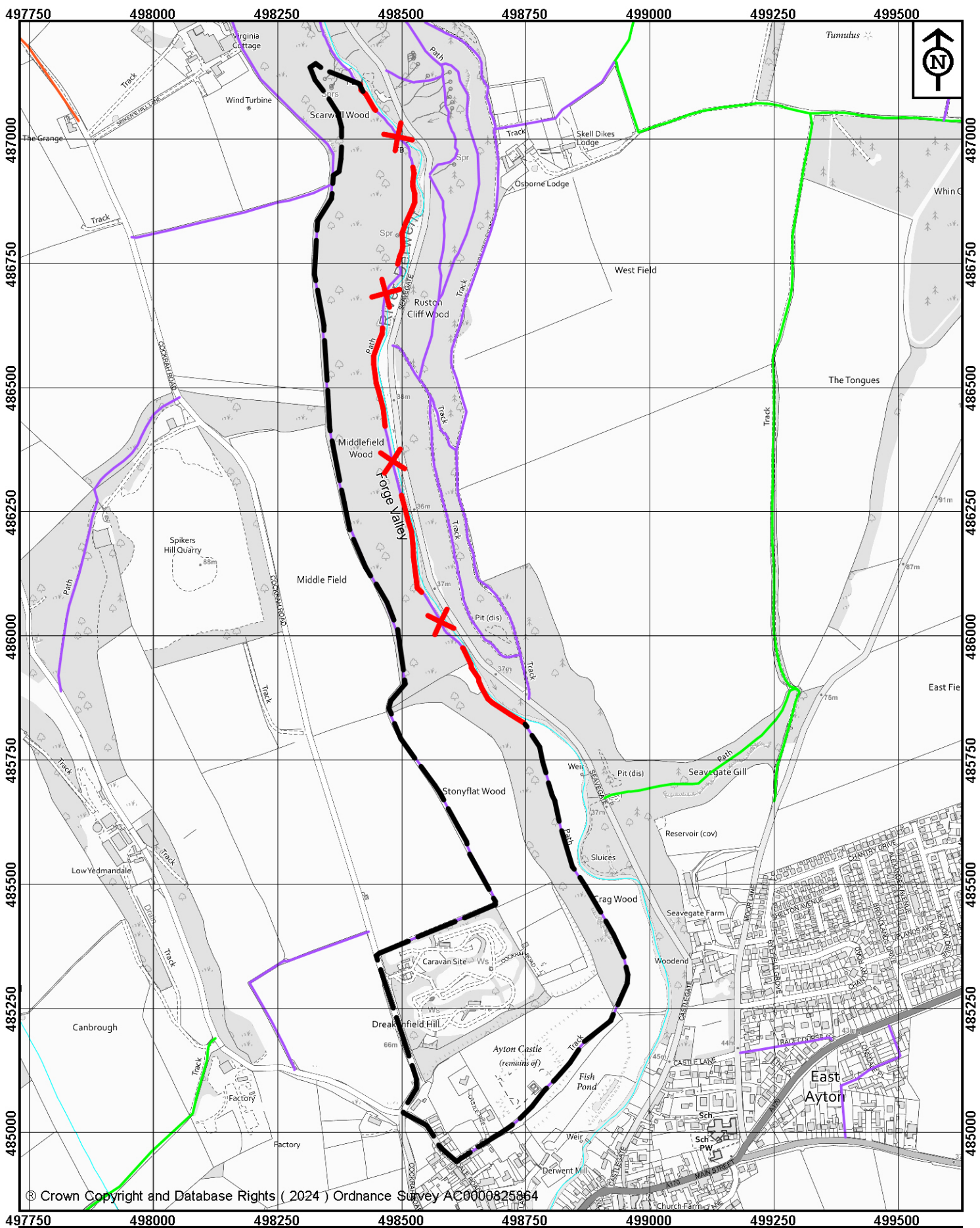
NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpath 30.22/001/1 in the Parish of West Ayton between grid reference SE98418711 and SE98748582, due to damaged and deteriorating boardwalk, has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 12th September 2026 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs. An alternative route will be signed on site.

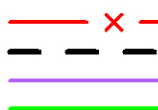
