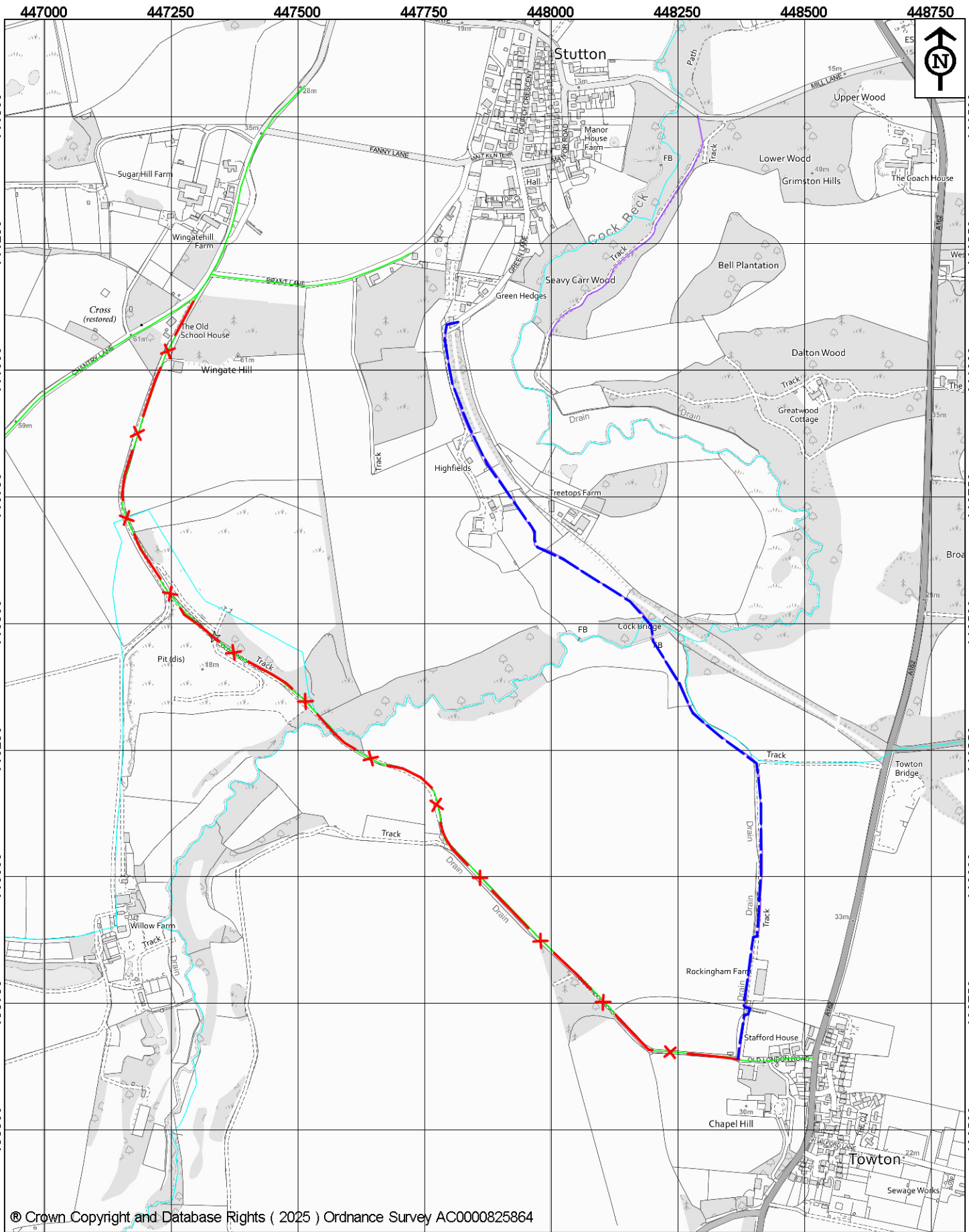
NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Bridleways 35.44/5/1, 35.69/1/1 & 39.63/9/3 in the Parishes of Lead, Towton & Sutton With Hazlewood, between grid references SE47294113 and SE48363964 due to an unsafe bridge has been continued in force for a further twelve months until (16th September 2026) or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs. An alternative route will be signed on site. Please note the alternative route is for pedestrians only.
